7. SCA Fiddle Paintings At this time Tracy Maybray from the Springville Center for the Arts (SCA) addressed the Mayor and Board. Ms. Maybray expressed that it is the desire of the SCA to paint more fiddles on the sidewalks in Fiddlers Green Park, Franklin St., Mechanic St. as well as on Factory Street. The proposed paintings would be similar to the current fiddles that were painted in 2019 but adding color as well as some musical notes. They would be painted in the end of June before Fiddlefest and supplies will be paid for by the Fiddlefest Committee. The project has already been presented to and approved by the Historic Preservation Commission as well as the Village Arts Committee.
